In just three years, the AADC has significantly expanded LANXESS's local innovation capabilities. Initially, the center focused on three specific business units: Polymer Additives (PLA), Lubricant Additives Business (LAB), and Urethane Systems (URE). In 2022, it added a fourth business unit, Material Protection Products (MPP), with a specialized microbiology laboratory.

This is in line with the company's transformation over the past few years into a specialty chemicals company with a focus on less cyclical additives and solutions for consumer protection, such as disinfectants for healthcare and livestock, and flavors and fragrances for personal care.

China's role in the chemical market has evolved from being primarily a manufacturing hub to a significant consumer market. It accounts for 40% of global chemical sales, a figure expected to approach 50% by 2030. This market shift has led LANXESS to localize products to meet the demands of China's growing middle class.
