1. Brief outline on CSR Policy of the Company :

The Company is committed to taking into consideration the diverse requirements of economics, ecology and society. Consequently, the Company takes decisions based not only on financial parameters, but also by keeping in mind the social and environmental impact arising out of the actions of the Company. The resultant Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Policy guidelines have also been drafted in line with the Company's Corporate Strategy and its commitment to Corporate Responsibility.

The Company selects CSR projects through a bottom-up approach, wherein the needs of the communities are identified in the areas of Climate Protection, Education, Water conservation and management among others, in the vicinity of the areas of its operations.
