The greenhouse gas emissions reduced by this process in one year are equivalent to the total carbon dioxide emissions of 300,000 Chinese households.

LANXESS' green practices also extend to continuous innovation on the product side. are produced using more environmentally friendly raw materials and renewable energy, with a Product Carbon Footprint (PCF) reduced by approximately 35% compared to traditional Bayferrox® products – a figure verified through a Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) certified by TÜV Rheinland Germany.

Collaborating Across the Value Chain to Advance Climate Neutrality

LANXESS has set a goal to achieve climate neutrality across its upstream and downstream supply chains by 2050. To fulfill this commitment, the company launched the "Net-Zero Value Chain Program," aiming to join hands with enterprises across the value chain to play a role in gradually achieving carbon reduction targets. Through three core pillars – sustainable raw materials, green logistics, and climate-neutral products – the program collaborates with upstream suppliers and downstream customers to build full-lifecycle carbon reduction capabilities.

LANXESS' commitment to climate protection has been recognized by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi). The organization has validated LANXESS' emission reduction targets and confirmed that the company is helping to limit global warming to a maximum of 1.5°C.

As a multinational enterprise deeply rooted in the Chinese market, LANXESS will continue to pursue the path of green and low-carbon development through technological innovation and energy efficiency improvement. It will also cooperate with local partners to contribute to the high-quality development of China's chemical industry and the achievement of the "dual carbon" goals.
